

## **Franklin County Advertisement for Bids: Alligator Point Beach Restoration Project (Time Correction)**

FRANKLIN COUNTY is requesting sealed bids from any qualified individuals or firms in constructing the Alligator Point Beach Restoration Project. BIDS will be received until 4:00 p.m., E.T., on Monday, January 14, 2008 at the office of the Clerk of Circuit Court, 33 Market Street, Suite 203, Apalachicola, FL 32320, and the bids will be opened in the Commission Chambers at the Courthouse Annex, 34 Forbes Street, Apalachicola on Tuesday, January 15 at 10:00 a.m., E.T. The public is invited to attend.

A MANDATORY Pre-BID Meeting will be held on Friday, January 4, 2008 at 10:30 a.m., E.T., at the Commission Chambers. Point of Contact will be Michael Dombrowski, P.E. at 850-654-1555. BIDS will only be accepted from firms in attendance at this pre-BID meeting.

The Work consists of dredging approximately 1.7 million cubic yards of sand obtained from an offshore borrow area and placed between DEP Monuments R-209 and R-226.5 to construct a 2.9 mile beach and dune restoration project. Approximately 450,000 sea oats will be supplied and installed by the SUCCESSFUL BIDDER.

The date for the FINAL COMPLETION of the Work shall be 180 days from the date of the NOTICE TO PROCEED presented to the SUCCESSFUL BIDDER. Liquidated damages for failure to complete the Work within the specified time frame shall be \$5,000.00 per day.

All BIDS must be made on the required BID Forms. All blank spaces for BID prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and the BID Form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Please indicate on the envelope your company name, that this is a sealed bid, and the project name. The original bid plus six (6) copies should be included.
